

June 2nd, 2016 MEETING

Meeting called to order at 7:00PM

Roll call of officers: All Present.

Motion to post Meeting Notes on the club website was passes by a majority vote.

Bills: no "new" bills, all bills have been paid.

Conservation/Stocking: Talked to a guy from DEP, to look at the pond, and see if we can open up the walkway down to the pond. Will take the rest of the summer and the fall to get everything prepped.

Scholarship: No new business.

Legislative: No new business.

By-Laws: No new business, will bring up the amendment to article 22 at the next e-board meeting.

Acton Fair: No new business.

Gun Show: No new business.

Hunter Safety: The Schedule has been put together; there will be two (2) classes;

1st Class: Monday October 3rd & Sunday October 16th

2nd Class: Tuesday October 4th & Saturday October 15th

Trapping: No new business.

Trap Shoot: Starting in June, and will go right through until the weather breaks.

Membership: Total Membership is now at 533 members

Building: No new business.

Sanford Range:

- On Clean-up day, 12 people came to help and got a lot done. Thank you to those who helped!

- A Week after Clean-up day, someone brought and shot up a computer tower and then left the mess behind. Also, a 4-5gal jug of insect poison was also shot at and the mess was left behind.

Requesting \$1000 worth of stone dust to fix up the road and other areas of the range.

- At the second rifle range, would like to put in 2 6" posts to block anyone from plowing the area in front of the door where stone dust was put down.

- Would also like to put up warning signs at each of the ranges, as part of Article 22 in the Bylaws.

- Disciplinary Action; can the party that's being charged, represent themselves at the e-board meeting – did we ever put into writing that they are the only ones who can represent themselves? If not, proposed an amendment of article 22;

"No member facing corrective action at an executive committee meeting shall be represented or defended by legal counsel."

The amendment will be brought up at the next e-board meeting.

Snowplow bids: Next month, will start looking for bids for snow plowing.

Berwick Range: Continuing construction to improve Cowboy Town. Boards need to be cut to length.

Will have to take a look at the building at the 200-yard range, the trim was starting to come off, Bruce hit it back into place but the wall shook "like nothing was holding it up".

Parliamentary: No new business.

Cowboys: SIG Shoot is on June 18th. Safety meeting starts at 9:00am, and Sign-up starts at 7:30am.

Had 19 shooters at their last shoot, and they all had a good time and good weather.

3-Gun Shoot: Next shoot will be on June 26th at Country Pond. The last shoot had 29 shooters, and turned over \$540.00 from the match.

Archery: Shoot on June 25th-26th, and set up on the 24th.

Junior Archery: No new business.

Range Safety: No new business.

Elections of Motions: Motion presented to allocate \$1000.00 to cover the cost of stone dust for earth work at the Sanford Range was voted upon and passed by a majority vote.

Motion was presented to buy four (4) 6-plate centerfire armored racks (\$1500.00 per rack, total of \$6000) for both the Sanford and Berwick Ranges (2 each), was presented and passed by a majority vote.

Unfinished Business: Representatives from Bauneg Beg Lake Association (Ann Whitten - President, Don - Treasure, and Dave Peterson – Trustee) attended the meeting to discuss Insurance. They have been working since January to try and get them Insurance, the least expensive coverage they can get is \$10,000.00 and they don't have the money for it. Right now, they don't have insurance, and they don't know if they will be able to get insurance.

The Club had already decided to let Bauneg Beg hold their yard sale without insurance because it was such short notice, however, they would have to pay rent (\$125 per day) for use of the hall during the yard sale. Haven't discussed what to do about the three meetings they have on the last Sunday in May, July and August.

Issue that has been a problem in the past with the yard sale; the A/C is on in the building, but someone is opening the windows and doors while the A/C is still on. Eventually the A/C will be padlocked and shut off so only Committee Members can access it.

New Business: In order to get more members and more people involved with the club, we need to offer more to the club. Would like to get some centerfire 6-plate racks (\$1500.00 per rack, x4) for both the Sanford and Berwick ranges. They will be chained to the building. Members can only access them during functions, or once they have gained the trust of the committee.

A motion was made to buy four of the 6-plate centerfire armored racks, and was passed by a majority vote.

For the good of the organization: 50/50 won by Carl Tymaniewicz, Club raffle was won and lost by John Baiguy.
