

November 2nd, 2017 MEETING

Meeting called to order at 6:58PM

Roll call of officers: All present.

Mail: A few magazines.

Don also want's \$1,500.00 to cover coming expenses (Lime, Dock, Lumber at the Pond, Dock at Bauneg Beg, and what ever is left over for Fish in the spring). There is nothing left over from before.

A motion was made to give Don a \$1,500.00 for his budget for the two docks and lime to finish up the pond. Motion passed by a majority vote.

Don will lime again 4-5 years from now.

The cost to stock will be about \$600.00 (about \$2.75 per fish, possibly brook trout). The pond is private to club members, and will be Catch and Release only. A chain will be put up, just like at the ranges, at the entrance of the path to the pond. Because it's a private pond, you don't need a license to fish at it.

The last time the pond had fish in it, it was run by the State. Last time, all the fish died. There are concerns that we are putting a lot of money into this project for it to only become a money pit. The Club will decide to keep restocking it from year to year.
