Damages at ranges: DO NOT post any targets on the 4x4 posts or the 2x4s that hold the backboards. Place your targets on the backboards and away from the 4x4 posts and 2x4s. We spend a lot of money on lumber every year so that you can have backboards to tack your targets onto. There is no need for the damage that is being done to these frame works by bullets. I'm still seeing where "members" ??? are putting rocks out in the ranges to shoot at. DO NOT shoot at rocks, your bullets will not stay in the range if you hit the rock. Remember, your bullets must impact into the berm after going through your target. Please, think safety at all times while at the ranges.

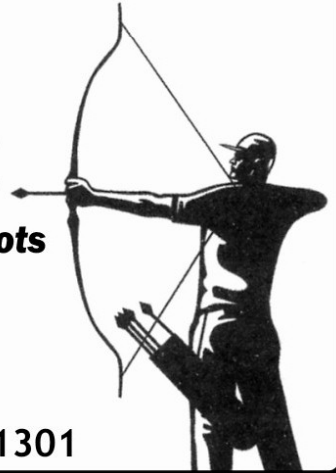

ATTENTION ARCHERS !!!

Along with our 3-D shoots this year, we will also have a summer FUN league which will consist of a 15 week span starting in mid May and ending the last week of August. The details are as follows:

The cost for SSF&G members will be \$15 (or \$1/week). The cost for non members will be \$30 (or \$2/week).

League fees will be paid in advance. 2/3 of league fees collected will go toward prizes.

Kids under 14 shoot for free.

Participants may shoot any time the range is open when there are no other events schedule (usually the only regularly scheduled event is trap on Sunday morning).

Non members must be escorted by a member to participate.

The league will consist of a 20 Target course.

The league is scored by way of the honor system and scores are turned in weekly.

All shooter will shoot from the Yellow stake.

Prizes will consist of local area gift certificates (i.e. Cabelas, Kittery Trading Post or Brian's Archery Shop).

For every week a member shoots, he receives a chance at the prize drawing.

At the end of the league prizes will be drawn from all the chances. So therefore if you only shoot 12 of the 15 weeks you will get 12 chances at winning a prize. Nobody can win more than one prize.

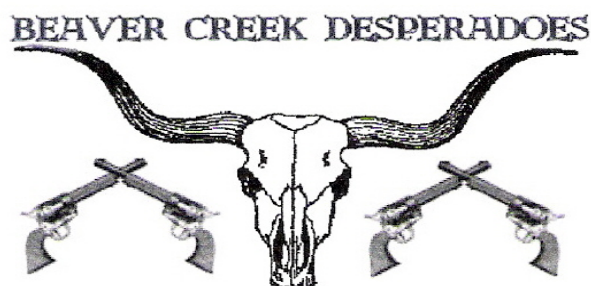

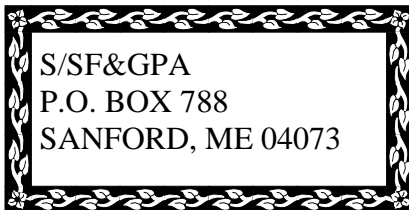
