We spend a lot of money on lumber every year so that you can have backboards to tack your targets onto. There is no need for the damage that is being done to these frame works by bullets. I'm still seeing where "members" ??? are putting rocks out in the ranges to shoot at. DO NOT shoot at rocks, your bullets will not stay in the range if you hit the rock. Remember, your bullets must impact into the berm after going through your target. Please, think safety at all times while at the ranges.

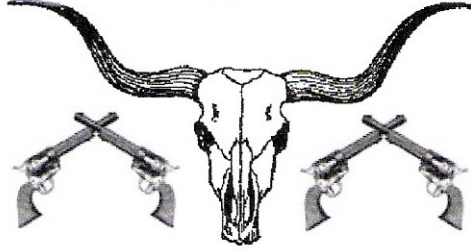

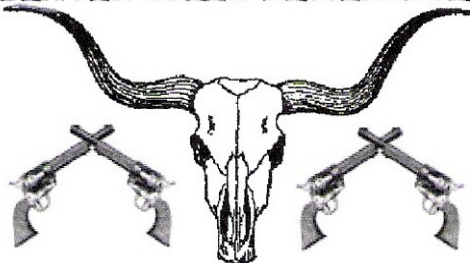
