Meeting called to order at 7:00PM

Roll call of officers: All present except President Bruce White and Treasurer Debra Grispi.

**Mail:** No new business.

**Bills:** Sherry presented what she had, but nothing was passed to the committee.

**Conservation/Stocking:** No new business.

**Scholarship:** The Scholarship has been given out, but the name was not submitted to Bonnie yet. She will be told after graduation (June 5<sup>th</sup>).

Sherry made the decision, and told him no. He told her that he "didn't want to step on us" and that he has the dates for all of our shows. The last shoot (May 30<sup>th</sup>) was HOT! They had 32 shooters, and went very well. They also received compliments on the great berm work.

**Archery:** At last month's 2-day IBO shoot, 152 people attended, 132 of who were new attendees. They made more money in that one weekend than they had in the last four shoots total. The shoot went very well, heard no complaints, and would like to do it again next year.

One more shoot will be on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, and will be more of a local shoot. On August 29<sup>th</sup>, the targets will be taken down, and a short shoot will take place before hand until 1pm. At this shoot, if people help to take down the targets, they will be provided a free lunch. A flyer will be made up and posted as well.

**Junior Archery:** No new business.

**Range Safety:** Current issue with live rounds being thrown into the trash at the Berwick Range. Supplied at all the ranges, there are “Dud Buckets” that they can be put into. Bonnie also got a call from the trash company, complaining that after they emptied the trash and did the compacting, they could hear a “bang” sound. Thankfully there was not damage done to the truck.

**Unfinished Business:** The instillation of the lights at the club house is finished, and the club has already received back around \$2,200 from Energy Maine.

**New Business:** The chimney at the Berwick range will be left the way it is right now. Bruce was supposed to look into it. Jerry brought up just buying an improved insulated chimney, install it and be done with it. Possibly even get a stove shop put it in, that way they will install it and be responsible for it. Doug will look into it. Possibly have it fixed before winter.

The Bauneg Beg Lake Association Yard Sale has been canceled, and Seth McCoy is interested in putting in a snow plow bid for the Club House and the Range.
